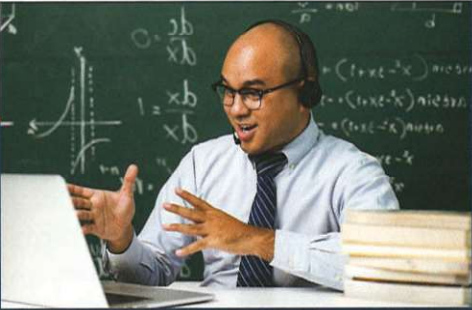

How It Works

Students complete 5 course credits (10 semester-length courses) online in addition to high school course work at their local school.

Simplified Admissions

Students apply to universities in our guarantee program using a streamlined application process that **waives the SAT, ACT, and TOEFL**.

Guaranteed Scholarships

Qualified graduates receive scholarships ranging from \$1,500 to \$20,000 USD. Amounts are determined based on the student's academic record and the university and program selected.
